The Apostles' Creed

Precepts of the Church

The precepts of the Church are laws that name specific actions that all Catholics are obliged to carry out.

1. Take part in the Mass on Sundays and holy days. Keep these days holy and avoid unnecessary work.
2. Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year if there is serious sin.
3. Receive Holy Communion at least once a year during Easter time.
4. Fast and/or abstain on days of penance.
5. Give your time, gifts, and money to support the Church.

4. Honor your father and your mother.
